Kevin T. Smith

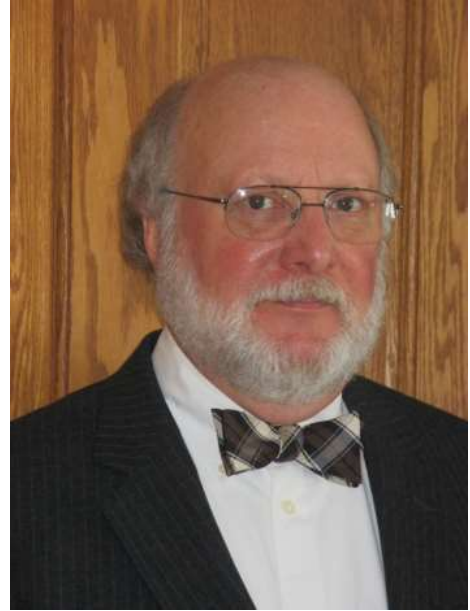
Retired
